9/20	L1	Residential Burglary	At 7:49 PM, unknown suspect(s) entered a residence in the 26000 block of Robleda Court by breaking a rear sliding glass door. The primary bedroom was searched but details of any stolen property have not yet been provided.
9/21	L3	Armed Robbery, Battery Causing Injury, Theft by Credit Card	At 2:42 PM, deputies responded to a robbery at a residence in the 25000 block of Altamont Road where two suspects entered the home through an open door. The victim resident encountered the suspects as they were searching the primary bedroom, whereupon one of the suspects threatened the victim with a knife and punched the victim in the face. The suspects took jewelry and a wallet before fleeing the scene, for a loss valued at \$5,050. Credit cards from the wallet were then used to make fraudulent purchases totaling approximately \$620. One suspect is known, on active probation, and in violation of related probation terms. The other suspect is unknown pending follow-up investigation. Both are at large.
