| 10/3 | L1   | Reckless Evading,<br>Identity Theft, Mail Theft<br>ARREST | At 7:30 PM, deputies recognized a vehicle with a stolen license plate at Foothill Expressway and El Monte Road after the vehicle triggered multiple automated license plate reader hits in the hour prior. An investigation revealed the license plate was stolen from a vehicle in San Francisco and was still outstanding. Deputies attempted to stop the vehicle, but the suspect driver did not yield and recklessly evaded until the vehicle became disabled in Hillsborough, where two suspects were taken into custody. The suspects were in possession of mail stolen from Los Altos Hills residents, including personal identifying information not belonging to either. Both were arrested and booked into San Mateo County Jail. |
| 10/5 | L3   | Forgery   | On 10/5, the victim reported unknown suspect(s), using unknown means, obtained the victim's check put into outgoing mail at a US Post Office in May of this year, and then altered, forged, and cashed the check for approximately \$9,200. The victim lives in Los Altos Hills.  |
| 10/5 | L1   | Residential Burglary                                      | At 7:58 PM, two unknown suspects entered a residence in the 26000 block of Robb Road by breaking a sliding glass door and stole handbags of an unknown value.   |
