## Volunteer Opportunities on the Planning Commission

Los Altos Hills encourages and welcomes residents to become involved in the local community, and contribute to the success of the Town. The Los Altos Hills City Council invites applications from interested residents to serve on the **PLANNING COMMISSION** for a term of four years. The term is from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2026.

There are two (2) vacancies on the Planning Commission. The Commission typically meets the first Thursday of the month to review and decide on planning permits for routine and complex or controversial development projects. The Planning Commission also advises the City Council on matters pertaining to the Zoning and Site Development Ordinance and the General Plan.
